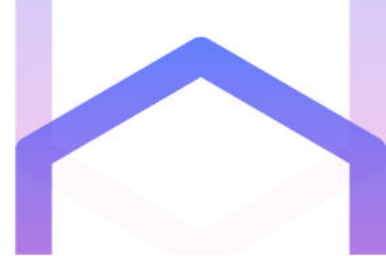

# REGISTRATION



## § 1. Competitor Registration

---

1. Competitor registrations must be submitted by 18 May 2026.
2. Registration is carried out exclusively in electronic form via the website:  
<http://www.danceit.pl>.
3. The registration system will open on 19 March 2026.

## § 2. Entry Limitations

---

1. If the number of registrations exceeds the time capacity of the event, the Organizer reserves the right to close the entry lists at any time.
2. Information about the early closing of registrations will be published via the Organizer's social media channels.
3. In the event of early closure of the registration system:
  - changes to registrations are possible within 48 hours from the moment the system is closed,
  - after this time, the registration is considered final and binding,
  - withdrawal of part or all of a registration does not release clubs from the obligation to pay the entry fee.
4. The entry fee must be paid within 5 days from the date the registration system is closed.

## § 3. Music

---

1. In categories performed to own music, music files must be submitted together with the registration.
2. Replacement of music tracks is possible until 01 June 2026, regardless of the registration closing date.

## § 4. Changes to Registrations

---

1. All requests for changes to registrations must be sent exclusively by email to both addresses: [dorota@tanieckielce.pl](mailto:dorota@tanieckielce.pl), [t.pilewski@loocasdance.pl](mailto:t.pilewski@loocasdance.pl) (CC)
2. After 48 hours from the closing of the registration system:
  - changes will be accepted subject to organizational possibilities,
  - an administrative fee of 50 PLN per person / category will apply.



3. Registrations submitted after the deadline are subject to a double entry fee.
4. Removing a dancer or a team does not release participants from the obligation to pay the entry fee.
5. After the starting lists have been published, no changes to registrations are possible. Only deletions are allowed.

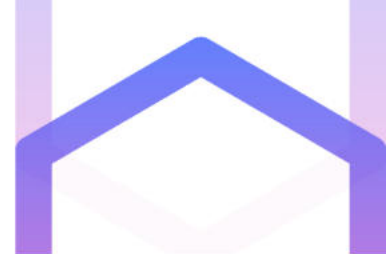

# RULES AND REGULATIONS



1. Dance floor dimensions:
  - solo, duos, groups – minimum 8 m × 8 m,
  - formations – minimum 12 m × 14 m.
2. The Organizer does not provide safety pins or number bib holders for start numbers.
3. A club or competitor has the right to withdraw from the competition at any stage of the Tournament. Withdrawal does not result in a refund of the entry fee.
4. A medical point will be available during the Tournament.
5. Changing rooms are publicly accessible – they are neither locked nor supervised. The Organizer is not responsible for items left in the changing rooms.
6. The responsibility for competitor insurance lies with the delegating institutions, which declare that their participants have valid insurance coverage. The Organizer does not provide supervision over Tournament participants.
7. All competitors are required to use dance shoes or perform barefoot.
8. The use of high heels (“stiletto”) or any footwear that may damage or scratch the dance floor surface is prohibited.
9. Any form of advertising conducted within the Tournament venue requires written consent from the Organizer.
10. All participants are obliged to strictly follow Health & Safety and Fire Safety regulations in force at the Wilanów Sports Center.
11. Participation in the Tournament constitutes free-of-charge and unlimited consent to the recording, storage, and publication of photographic and video materials from dance performances for the Organizer’s promotional and informational purposes.
12. Protests are accepted only in written form within 15 minutes after the end of a given competition and upon payment of a deposit of 200 PLN.
13. The protest will be reviewed by the Head Judge and the Organizer.  
If the protest is rejected, the deposit is non-refundable and will be retained by the Organizer.
14. Detection of age discrepancies among competitors will result in the disqualification of the entire club and publication of this information publicly.
15. The Organizer reserves the right to transfer a competitor or performance to another category in case of irregularities found in the registration.
